

November 27, 2007 Children's Corner Board Membership Minutes

In Attendance: Kaiser, Beaver, Eyer, Berger, England

1. We will vote on October minutes at the January meeting.
2. Class configuration for next year; the board will discuss it as a whole instead of forming a committee. Mrs. England will get opinions and suggestions from the teachers the next time they meet. (such things as: leave everything as is, be stricter about age guidelines, Little 2's go to two days a week, any teacher willing to teach an afternoon class if it was offered).
3. The board members present decided to leave holiday bonuses the same as last year (five teachers, bookkeeper, church secretary, Spanish teacher). The director was not present for this discussion.
4. For the Holiday Family Party, we will have each class bring a specific type of food (finger sandwiches, fruit and vegetables, desserts, etc.). Cari will get plates, napkins, cups, spoons and etc. Maybe we will have a flyer closer to the date to remind people of the details. It will be in the next newsletter. The date is December 21, from 12-12:45.
5. Leslie will be sending out to families a school evaluation online (to take place of the written one included in the newsletter).
6. The bad weather policy will be included in the newsletter to give parents a heads up for possible school closings, etc.
7. The Spring open house will possibly be scheduled around Dr. Seuss's birthday; we may be able to sponsor something at the public library. The tentative date is March 3. More details will be coming later.
8. Fundraising report: Aver's night = \$290+; Rosie Pizzo is organizing a Barnes and Noble day on Dec. 15th which we will hand out and email vouchers for; a Jimmy John's night (like the Aver's one) something in Jan. (Leslie would like to do some kind of restaurant thing once a month); possible chair massage day at school for parents (ask Leslie about this one!); Perdergasts will underwrite a Lotus Blossom Music concert in the gym where we would be hosts (during school time, possibly tied into the spring open house?).
9. From Adam: He is still talking with the Church regarding how much is our monthly share of the DSL hook-up; possibly about \$25 a month. Teachers: will you take advantage of internet hook-up if we have it available?
- 10: Enrollment: openings = 2 in Jan. Little 2's (Dair and Tammy will take these spots if they aren't filled by Jan. 1), 1 in Rachel's class, 1 in Lora's class.
11. Cari will organize big clean-up days right before Christmas break, Spring break, and the

end of the school year. Teachers: do you care when the one is before Christmas break? If there is no Lunch Bunch that week of Dec. 17-21, it would need to be the Friday before (Dec.14) so the parents can take advantage of using Lunch Bunch. Is this OK? Mrs. England asked Cari about maybe getting some people to just wash the toys in the rooms. Also - we may need to re-evaluate the structure of the Facilities Committee in the Spring.
